## How to Pack Your Shoebox

For a trip around the world:

1. Pick up a shoebox (or two) from the narthex and a "Boy" or "Girl" label(s).
2. Include a "wow" toy such as a doll, soccer ball with pump, stuffed animal, etc.
3. Add other fun toys, hygiene items (no toothpaste or liquids), school supplies, clothing, etc. to fill the box completely.
4. Include a \$9.00 donation to cover costs of shipping. If you go to [samaritanaspurse.org/occ](http://samaritanaspurse.org/occ), select "Follow Your Box," pay on-line, and print out your shoebox label, you will discover the destination of your shoebox. In the past, shoeboxes sent from members at Shepherd of the Rockies have gone to India and Mexico.
5. Bring back to the church no later than Sunday, November 12.

Have you picked up your box yet? Boxes are available in the narthex.

This project is sponsored by

**Samaritan's Purse**, a Christian organization headed by Franklin Graham, whose father is the evangelist, Billy Graham. These shoeboxes go worldwide to children whose Christmas is far different from what most of our families experience in America.

You can choose the age range and sex of the child(ren) for whom you would like to pack box(es). Please include **\$9.00 per box for shipping**; either cash or check made payable to Samaritan's Purse with "Operation Christmas Child" in the memo line. If you pay online and print out your label, your box will be tracked and you will discover to which country your box has been shipped. You can also purchase plastic shoeboxes to fill. You can start bringing in your filled shoeboxes at any time, but the **FINAL** collection date is **Sunday, November 12**.
